This Road Race takes place in the Sangre de Cristo mountains in northern New Mexico. The course is a 14.7 mile climb, including approximately 3300ft of vertical climb. The start line is at Fort Marcy Park.

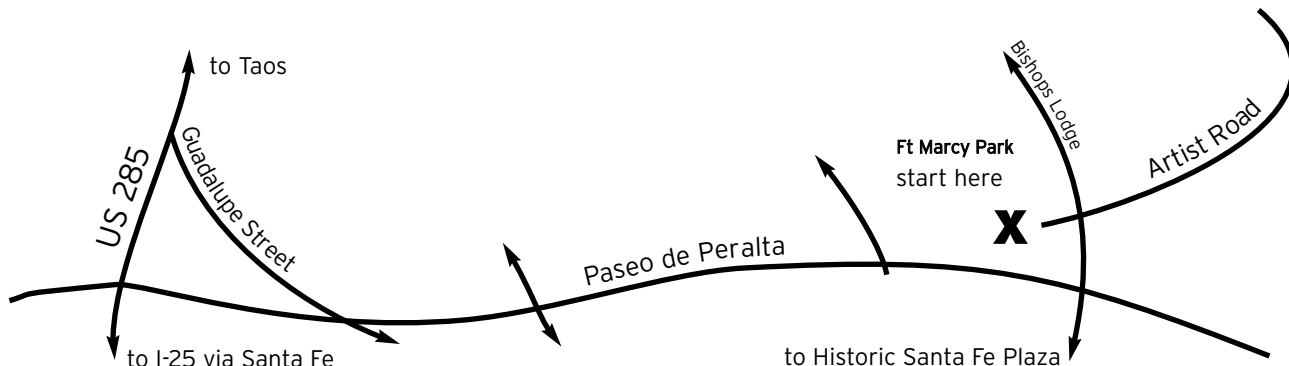
Everyone ready to race at 8:30. NO PERSONAL SAGS! This creates unmanageable traffic jams on these narrow roads and put future permits at risk!
