Helmets must be worn at all times, racing or warming up. This event is open to all racers, in or out of state. Pro, out of state racers, and non-annual ACA members are not eligible for medals.

Medals awarded to 3 places in each event. **\$500 in cash prizes will be awarded.**

Entry Fee: \$20 if postmarked by June 26th. Juniors race free if they race as juniors. All riders need an ACA license. **One-day licenses available at \$5. Late Registration add \$5. Unattached riders add \$5. Each additional criterium is \$5.** Riders may sign up in person at SportzOutdoor on June 30<sup>th</sup> from 4-7 pm. Make checks payable to Olev Rapido. There will be a \$5.00 late fee for race day registration. Race day registration will close 15 minutes before each race starts.

- If you are traveling south towards Albuquerque on I-25, exit west on Alameda Boulevard. Turn left or South on Alameda Park. Turn right or West on Paseo Alameda, continue through and you will have reached the course.
- If you are traveling North towards Albuquerque on I-25, exit west on Alameda Boulevard. Turn left or South on Alameda Park. Turn right or West on Paseo Alameda, continue through and you will have reached the course.
- Those traveling East or West on I-40 should exit onto I-25 North and follow the previous directions for traveling North.

\* Competitors driving to the races may **not** enter or leave the course during a race.
