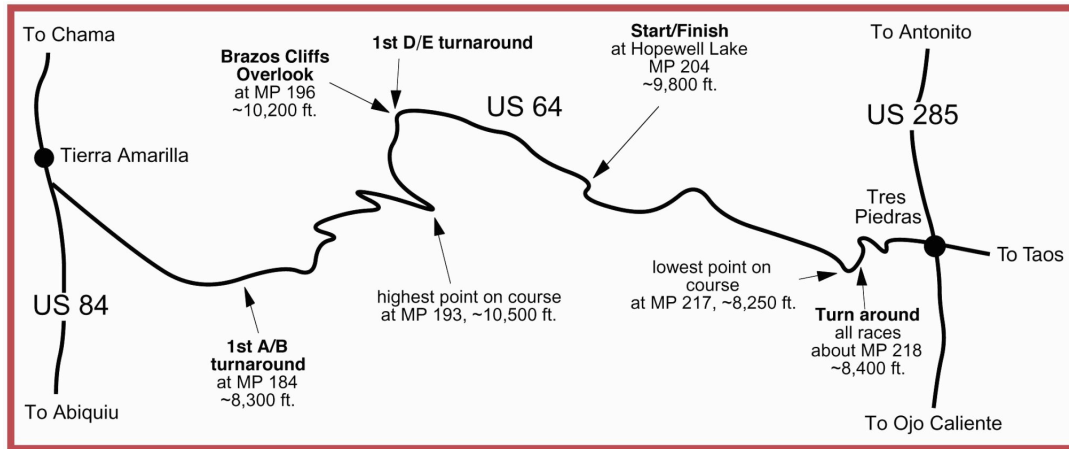

New Mexico Road Series

June 16, 2007



Course

This road race takes place across from Hopewell Lake on US 64 in the Brazos Mountains in Northern New Mexico. The course is a double out-and-back of 66 miles for the A and B races, 42 miles for the D and E races, and a single out-and-back of 27 miles for the C (senior men, juniors & citizens) races. These courses feature abundant climbing at an average elevation of over 9,500 feet.

Directions

From Taos: US64 west to Hopewell Lake 52 miles

From Albuquerque: I-25N to Santa Fe, US84/285 N. thru Espanola, R. on US285 to Tres Piedras, L. on US64 to Hopewell Lake, 163 miles.
